



### **Owner's Responsibility for Safe Rowing**

It's important that you insure your boat before picking it up at our storage shop in Wilmington or arranging for its delivery. If using a third party for delivery, be certain with your insurance carrier that it is covered for transport under those circumstances. We can provide you and your insurance agent with the serial number and valuation.

It's important for your enjoyment and safety that you observe the following rules before rowing your boat.

1. Unwrap your boat soon after it arrives home so that any water that seeped into the bag during transport can dry out.
2. Check the serial number for accuracy with your order.
3. Read the owner's manual and familiarise yourself with your boat.
4. Check that you have all the porthole/bung covers, that the bowball is attached and not loose, and that the heel-restraints permit no more than 3cm of lift off the stretcher board.
5. If rowing in the dark, make sure you have the proper lights for your local waterway.
6. Make sure all nuts and bolts are tight.
7. Similar checks should be made at regular intervals, particularly with a new boat and/or after transport.
